People attending an emergency department with a head injury have a CT head scan within 1 hour of a risk factor for brain injury being identified. Rationale Head injuries can be fatal or cause permanent disability if damage to the brain is not identified and treated quickly.

1.4.7 For adults who have sustained a head injury and have any of the following risk factors, perform a CT head scan within 1 hour of the risk factor being identified: GCS less than 13 on initial assessment in the emergency department. GCS less than 15 at 2 hours after the injury on assessment in the emergency department.

The use of CT scans in the US has reportedly tripled since 1993 to its present level of about 70 million scans per year.
