To help Weber understand and explain individual's behaviors he developed four types of social action. Firstly, he developed instrumental-rational action; meaning an action in which an individual's attempts to pursue their goals outweighing the advantages and disadvantages along the way.

Weber's Ideal Types as Models in the Social Sciences of a historical or societal situation. It is immaterial whether the historical or societal reality actually corresponds to the types. ## **Max Weber's Social Action Theory - ReviseSociology**

Weber articulated three ideal types of domination: charisma, tradition and rational-legal. Charismatic domination rests on the character of the leader. The social action theory was founded by Max Weber. There are two main types of sociological theories; the first is the structural or macro theory while the other is social action, interpretive or micro perspectives.

In Weber's view, social actions could be classified into four types: "instrumentally rational (zweckrational)," "value-rational (wertrational)," "affectual," and "traditional," though he noted that this list was not necessarily "exhaustive" (E&S 1.1.2).

## **Max Weber on Rationality in Social Action, in Sociological ...**

Max Weber now presents his own classification of the four ideal types of social action. The first one is called [FOREIGN] which can be translated as goal-rational or means, ends, rational. This is social action that is motivated by the desire to reach in the most efficient way, an end result that can also be defended with rational arguments.

The three-component theory of stratification, more widely known as Weberian stratification or the three class system, was developed by German sociologist Max Weber with class, status and power as distinct ideal types. Weber developed a multidimensional approach to social stratification that reflects the interplay among wealth, prestige and power.

Weber used ideal-types to derive three forms of domination. The first type is charismatic domination, or power based on the exceptional qualities of an individual, such as his or her heroism or sanctity. The second type of legitimate domination is traditional domination, or power that is justified by a belief in long-standing customs.
